Shell Corena Rotary Screw Compresessor Cleaner Concentrate is a fully formulated, concentrated system cleaner containing synthetic ester, cleaning, lubricity and corrosion inhibitor additives. It is miscible in mineral oils, synthetic hydrocarbons, ester oils and polyglycols.

Shell Corena Rotary Screw Compresessor Cleaner Concentrate is specifically designed for cleaning rotary screw compressors, hydraulic systems, gear and other circulating mineral oil systems. When added to the system at a 1–10% basis, Shell Corena Rotary Screw Compresessor Cleaner Concentrate will dissolve varnish and carbon deposits during normal operation and keeps them suspended in the compressor oil.

This can all be done without dismantling the system and ensures that the entire system is cleaned (pumps, valves, tubing, heat exchanges, filter housings, etc.) prior to draining and refilling with fresh oil. A clean system will extend the service life of the new oil charge, reduce future maintenance costs and increase the system reliability.

• Directions for Use

Add Shell Corena Rotary Screw Compresessor Cleaner Concentrate to the oil reservoir, allowing for a 1-10% addition. Operate the machine for 40-60 hours at 70-80 °C, if possible. The higher operating temperature will help to dissolve the varnish, carbon deposits and sticky residues. While the oil is still hot, immediately drain the system including all tubing, filter housing, heat exchangers and dead/low flow circuits to insure there will be no crosscontamination with the fresh charge of oil. Pay close attention to the filters and other cleaning devices during this cleaning process, and change/clean filters as necessary. Finally, change the filters and oil separators and refill the reservoir with fresh oil.

When cleaning gearboxes and/or systems under heavy load, consideration must be given to the viscosity and wear protection of the 'mixed fluid'.
